A devotional facility for 4-H camps and sponsored events as well as for visiting organizations such as schools, corporations, environmental education programs, and communions.



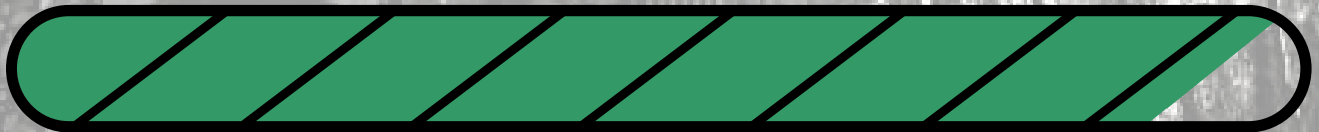
A public speaking and performing arts platform for four District Project Achievement competitions, Junior Classical League, and Georgia Association for Student Councils.

MISSION

In addition to insurance funds, the University of Georgia Risk Management team estimate an additional \$650,000 are needed to restore the building to the American Disability Act code. This estimate does not include funds needed for interior elements, such as pews, windows, chandeliers, and more.



An email campaign, which included recognition opportunities, was sent to all 4-H supporters, garnering gifts that range from \$ 1 to \$ 10,000. As of December 1, \$600,000 has been raised to defray the costs of the interior of the building from this effort. Another appeal email as well as a direct mailing will go out soon. Other asks for support will be directed to specific donors.
